

VOTER GUIDE 2020



CAN I VOTE?

You must be 18 or older on Election Day, a U.S. citizen, and registered to vote.

Register or check your registration status by **Oct. 13** (link below).

WHAT VOTER ID DO I NEED?

Bring your ID with you to vote early or on Election Day.

- Photo ID no longer required. Acceptable IDs: VA driver's license, voter card, utility bill, documents with your name and address, employee ID with photo, or college student ID.
- Voters who do not have an acceptable ID may sign a sworn ID confirmation.



WHEN & WHERE DO I VOTE?

VOTE EARLY IN PERSON

Sept. 18 - Oct. 31 | Monday-Friday | Two Saturdays, Oct. 24 and Oct. 31 | Curbside voting available
You must vote at the early voting location(s) for the locality where you're registered.

VOTE ABSENTEE BY MAIL OR DROP BOX

Request a ballot online or by mail before Oct. 23. Use the Citizen Portal (link at right) or call your Voter Registrar.

Vote your ballot, put it in the white envelope, **sign the envelope**, put that envelope in the RETURN envelope and return it ASAP

- By mail, postmarked no later than Nov. 3 (no postage required)
- Drop off to early voting location by Nov. 2
- Take to additional ballot drop off locations for James City voters by Oct. 30
- Take it to Registrar's Office by 7 pm Nov. 3
- Bring it to your polling place on Election Day, Nov. 3 - 6 am - 7 pm

Your ballot does not need to be witnessed. You may bring someone else's sealed ballot to a ballot drop box or early voting location.

Polls open 6 am - 7 pm - Curbside voting available.
