

✓ REGISTER TO VOTE

You can register to vote in person, by mail, or online. After you submit your registration, you will receive a voter registration card.

1. Register in person

2. Register by mail [Download and print a copy of the voter registration form](#) or go to state or local government offices (when applying or recertifying for Aid to Dependent Children, Food Stamps, WIC, Medicaid, or Rehabilitation Services),

Armed forces recruitment offices, public libraries, Virginia Department of Elections office, DMV offices or during Voter Registration drives.

If you have questions, call your local registrar.

3. Register online

You can register to vote online at the [Virginia Department of Elections Citizen Portal](#). Here, you can also access your Virginia voter record to view and update your existing registration, apply to vote absentee, and view your polling place, election district, absentee ballot status, and voting history.

VOTING

General elections are every November. Polls are open 6:00 AM to 7:00 PM.

Be sure to bring one form of [Voter Identification](#) when voting. Valid ids include:

- Virginia Driver's License or ID Card
- Virginia DMV issued Veteran's ID card
- United States Passport
- Other government-issued ID cards (must be issued by US Government, the Commonwealth of Virginia, or a political body of the Commonwealth). Tribal enrollment or other tribal ID issued by one of 11 tribes recognized by the Commonwealth of Virginia
- College or university student ID card from a school of higher education located in Virginia
- Employee ID card issued by an employer of the voter in the ordinary course of the employer's business

Any U. S. Citizen who is a Virginia resident; at least 18 years old or will be at the next general election; not currently declared mentally incompetent by a court of law; not a convicted felon unless a felon with voting rights restored
